

## TWAS-Samira Omar Innovation for Sustainability Prize \_ Nomination 2018

Deadline: 31 May 2018

This new annual prize, sponsored by the TWAS Fellow Samira Omar, will recognize scientists from the Least Developed Countries (LDCs), for scientific achievements in an area of science related to sustainability.

The 2018 Prize will be awarded to a scientist who has been living and working in a LDC for at least the two years immediately prior to his/her nomination, for scientific achievements in the thematic area of **Plastic: degradation, pollution and microplastics**.

  - A supporting statement by the nominator
