### CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

*“The Leadership Training Programme & Network for Young Physicians”*

IAP for Health – part of the InterAcademy Partnership – is seeking candidates to participate in the 2016 Young Physician Leaders Programme in Berlin Germany during the World Health Summit in October 2016.

The programme has two parts:

- 8 & 9 October 2016 - A specific leadership development programme with a focus on analysing models of leadership with the aim of developing an individual action plan for personal leadership growth for implementation after the workshop.
- 9-11 October 2016 - Participation in the World Health Summit (<http://www.worldhealthsummit.org/>)

The aim of the programme is to foster a new generation of leaders in global health.

Candidates should be under 40 years of age with demonstrated outstanding accomplishments in clinical medicine, medical education, public health, health policy or health services management

**We are looking for individuals who show great promise for leadership in their chosen careers and in improving the health of their societies and we especially encourage the nomination of women.**

Candidates proposed by IAP member academies should be enthusiastic, with outstanding communication skills and the ability, desire and personality to represent the medical profession well when interacting with the professionals from multiple sectors who will also be attending the Summit.

Selection will be carried out by a scientific committee chaired by the IAP for Health co-chairs, consisting of an international panel of medical and scientific professionals.

Nominations will be accepted from academies that are members of the InterAcademy Partnership or the “M8 Alliance” (<http://www.worldhealthsummit.org/m8-alliance/mission.html>).

**Deadline for sending nominations is 30 June 2016.**

Successful candidates will be informed shortly thereafter.
